

RESOLUTION NO. 6-2009

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NAMPA, CANYON COUNTY, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING THE NAMPA AIRPORT COMMISSION TO APPROVE THE USE OF INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS AT THE NAMPA MUNICIPAL AIRPORT TO PROVIDE AVIATION MAINTENANCE, FLIGHT INSTRUCTION OR OTHER COMMERCIAL AVIATION ACTIVITY PENDING ADOPTION OF NEW MINIMUM BUSINESS STANDARDS FOR THE NAMPA MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the Nampa Airport Commission is in the process of drafting new minimum business standards for the Nampa Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, such new minimum business standards may conflict with existing Airport rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, because of a possible conflict, and pending the adoption of the new minimum business standards, the Nampa City Council, on November 19, 2008, passed a Resolution authorizing a 90-day moratorium on enforcing Airport regulations that prohibit airport tenants or subtenants from providing or hiring individuals to provide aviation maintenance, flight instruction or other commercial aviation activity for compensation or hire who do not have written permission from the Nampa Airport Commission; and

WHEREAS, the 90-day moratorium will expire on February 19, 2009, prior to adoption of the new minimum business standards for the Nampa Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of the City of Nampa, Canyon County, Idaho, that it would be advantageous and beneficial to the Nampa Municipal Airport and its tenants and subtenants to approve the use of Independent Contractors by tenants and subtenants of the Nampa Municipal Airport to provide aviation maintenance, flight instruction or other commercial aviation activity at the Nampa Municipal Airport pending the adoption of the new minimum business standards for the Nampa Municipal Airport and subject to the following criteria.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAMPA, IDAHO:

Section 1: The Nampa Airport Commission is hereby authorized to approve the use of Independent Contractors by tenants and subtenants of the Nampa Municipal Airport to provide aviation maintenance, flight instruction or other commercial aviation activity at the Nampa Municipal Airport, provided such Independent Contractors shall furnish the Nampa Airport Commission with a certificate of public liability insurance, naming the City of Nampa as an additional insured, showing public liability insurance is in full force and effect in the following particulars, to-wit:

- Comprehensive General Liability Insurance – protecting the City of Nampa against any and all liability by reason of the individual’s conduct incident to the use of the Premises, or resulting from any accident occurring on or about the roads, driveways,

or other public places, including runways and taxiways, used at the Airport, caused by or arising out of any negligent act or omission of the individual, in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00; and


- Aircraft Liability Insurance – for aircraft in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 (CSL), and \$100,000.00 per passenger; and
- Non-Owned Aircraft Liability Insurance – in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 (CSL), and \$100,000.00 per passenger; and
- Hangarkeeper’s Liability Insurance – in the minimum amount of \$50,000 for each aircraft, and \$100,000.00 for each occurrence; and
- Product Liability and Completed Operations Insurance – in the minimum amount of \$500,000.00; and
- Passenger Liability Insurance – in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000; and
- Product Liability Insurance – in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.

Section 2: In addition to the required insurance set forth in Section 1, this Resolution shall also be limited by CFR 14 FARS.
